Juarez's Politic Career

- ◉ Governor of Oaxaca 1856-1857.
- ◉ First exiled 1853.
- ◉ Returned 1854 to overthrow Santa Anna.
- ◉ Liberals appointed Vice-president Juarez as a president in 1857.

The War of Reform 1857.

The war left a deficit of \$400,000.

and England .

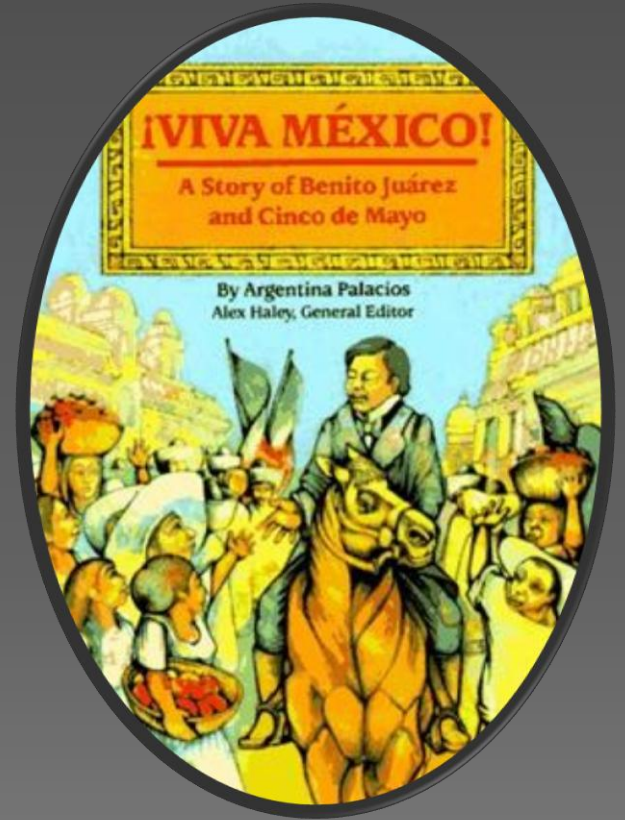


THE FRENCH INTERVENTION
